

WIFI and Alarm System Connection to Retirement Units

The installation of the Wi-Fi and Alarm system has nearly been completed with only four units waiting for antenna's to arrive from our supplier to complete installation across the entire complex.

These services are now available for connection to any residents who would like to have one or both services connected to their unit, so please let Keith or Reception know if you are interested. The pricing for these services have been set at levels slightly below those of other available providers. Note also that with regard to the resident alarm service there is a free service subsidized by the Victorian Government. The scheme has stringent guidelines and there is a waiting list of 4 to 6 months. Application for the free service can be made through Central Goldfields Shire. Any residents who are eligible for this service can guote Raglan House as their contact number.

Residents must agree to use this **emergency** service responsibly and may be levied a call out charge for inappropriate use. Havilah may discontinue this service for repeated inappropriate use of the system.

WIFI – Retirement Units

Establishment Fee \$99

Monthly Charge \$30/Month up to 250gb/month

Does not require a modem and this is a saving of \$80 -\$100 but may require a Wi-Fi adapter

if not built in (older computers) cost of adaptor \$35.00

No mail server but there are plenty of free mail servers available

Green Waste

Residents are reminded that on request they can have excess green waste collected by Maintenance Officer Stuart and transported to the local refuse centre for recycling. To assist with Refuse Centre charges Stuart requests residents supply him with 4 Council tip vouchers annually.

Any residents who would like to participate can take any spare or un-required vouchers to Reception at the Community Centre.




EFTPOS

UK STANDARD CROSSWORD 7 & 8


