If you do not currently have a Security Swipe tag for the Community Centre and would like one please contact Keith Fankhauser on 0408 774 715.

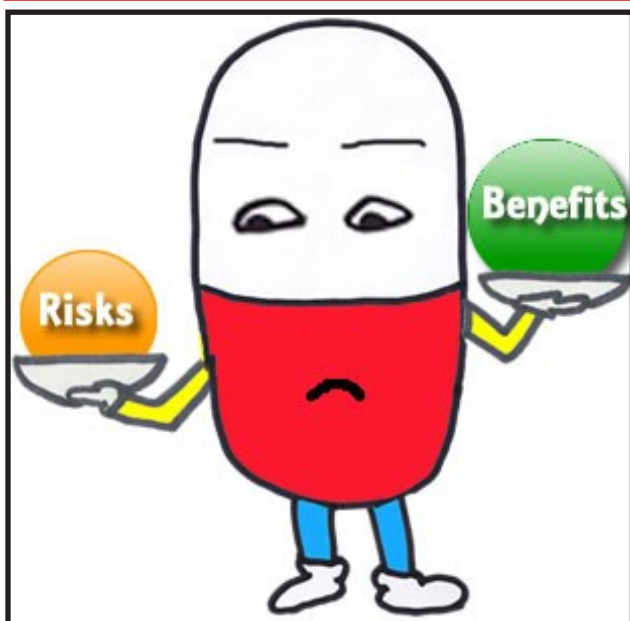

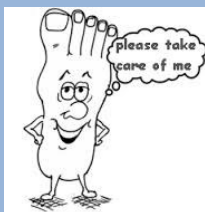

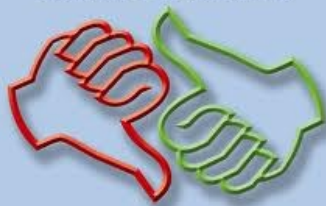

By now I was starting to smile.

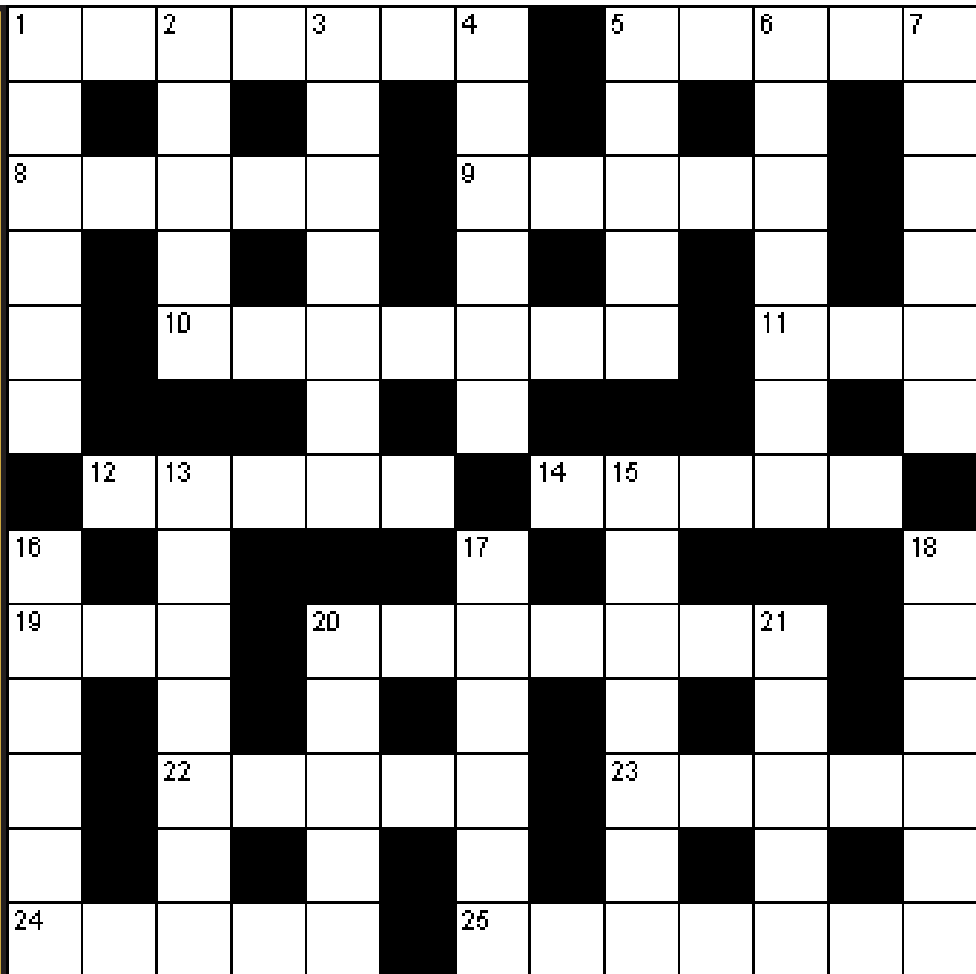
"Well, then, if I was kind to animals and gave sweets to all the children, and Loved my husband, would that get me Into heaven?"

Kinda brings a wee tear too your eye. Don't it!



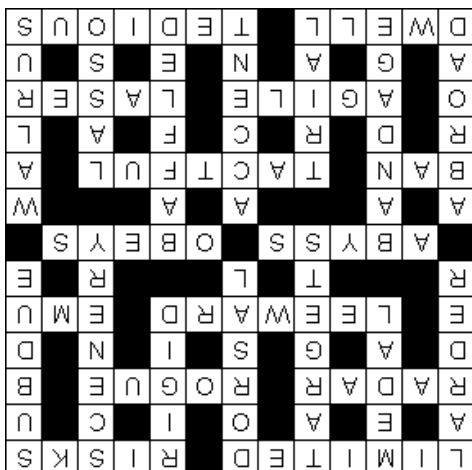
